

Important Information from the Office of the Municipal Agent

RENT REBATE FOR 2017: runs April 1, 2018 thru October 1, 2018 The Rent Rebate program provides a one-time yearly rebate to renters based on income, rent, and utilities that were paid for the previous year (2017).

Requirements for Eligibility:

All Applicants **MUST** be:

- 65 as of 12/31/17 OR receiving Social Security Disability benefits and over the age 18
- Have resided in the State of Connecticut for one full year at some time in your life and also be a resident of the State during time of application.

You must apply in the town/city in which you resided in 2017.

2017 income must not exceed <u>\$35,300</u> (single person), or <u>\$43,000</u> (married couple)

****Please Note:**

If you received cash benefits from the Department of Social Services (DSS), your rebate amount may be reduced or you may not qualify.

For applicants that applied last year, Rent Rebate Applications have already been mailed out. Please contact Michelle at 203-797-4686 if you have not yet received your application.

Completed and signed applications, along with required documentation, can be mailed to or brought to the Elmwood Hall – Danbury Senior Center.

All "**NEW**" applicants <u>**MUST**</u> call 203-797-4686 and Michelle or Joyce will schedule an appointment with you to see if you qualify.
