

## Tax Relief for Elderly and Totally Disabled 2024 Grand List

Applications for this program will be accepted February 1st – May 15th Applications are taken by appointment only

## **State Program**

Income Limits: Single – 45,200 Married - \$55,100 Gross Income Plus Social Security Benefit: 10-50% or \$150-\$1250 off taxes based on income

## Local Programs (pre-2024 GL)

#### 1) SAVE Program

Income Limit: Single – \$65,200 Married - \$75,100 Gross Income + Social Security Benefit: \$700 off Taxes Taxpayer must volunteer 100 hours of work with an approved non-profit Volunteer hours and Approved Non-Profits tracked by United Way

#### 2) Deferral Program

Income Limit: Single – \$55,200 Married - \$65,100 Gross Income + Social Security Benefit: 25% of Real Estate Taxes with a lien of 5% per Annum Maximum net assessment \$300,000

#### 3) Freeze Program

Income Limit: Single \$55,200 Married - \$65,100 Gross Income + Social Security...

# Local (cont)

... Benefit: Taxes frozen based on year of application This program was sunsetted after the 2022 Grand List for new applicants Any applicant that received the benefit on the 2022 Grand List can continue to apply and receive benefit as long as they meet income guidelines

#### 4) Local Program

Income Limit: Single – \$55,200 Married - \$65,100

Gross Income + Social Security Benefit: \$450 Single \$600 Married This program was sunsetted after the 2023 Grand List for new applicants Any applicant that received the benefit on the 2023 Grand List can continue to apply and receive benefit as long as they meet income guidelines

Income Limit: Single – \$55,200 Married - \$65,100 Gross Income + Social Security Benefit: \$250 Single \$350 Married This program was sunsetted after the 2023 Grand List for new applicants Any applicant that received the benefit on the 2023 Grand List can continue to apply and receive benefit as long as they meet income guidelines

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## New for 2024 GL

#### Senior and Totally Disabled Incentive

Must be a resident of Danbury for minimum of 1 Year

Must have paid taxes to the City for a Minimum of 1 Year

Must have all vehicles registered in the State of Connecticut

Market Value of Property must be no greater than twice the Median Home Value at last Revaluation (Median Valuation 2022 Revaluation was \$250,670, Value threshold \$501,340)

**Total Real Estate Assets must be no greater than three times the Median Home Value** (Value Threshold \$752,010)

Must be 65 Years old the December prior to filing or considered 100% disabled according to Social Security

**Meet Income Guidelines (In**come levels as established by OPM annually plus \$20,000; Gross Income plus Half (50%) Social Security)
